The following statement will serve as standing operating policy for all public statements of support or non-support by the Board of Directors of the East Cobb Civic Association, Inc., for any existing or pending zoning, variance, legislation and/or ordinance proposal:

"The primary mission of the East Cobb Civic Association, Inc. (ECCA) is to help protect the property values of its members and member organizations and to aid in maintaining consistent and appropriate property zonings in eastern Cobb County. This effort includes the periodic review of proposed zoning, variance and land use permit applications as well as review of proposed updates or revisions to existing ordinances by governmental authorities having jurisdiction. The ECCA has and will continue to review and comment on pending ordinances, land use plan legislation or ordinances that may change existing County ordinance, Georgia law, general practice or policy in such a way as to have impact on the residential property values, public safety, or public welfare of its constituents.

It shall be appropriate for the ECCA Board to discuss the review of existing or pending legislation or ordinance with its membership. However, when necessary to issue a position statement or public comment on these matters, the Board shall not be required in advance to survey its membership or vote at a membership call or regular meeting when such position or comment is consistent with the standing ECCA mission statement and general practice. Any public statement so made should be released primarily by the President and, if possible, with the concurrence in advance of the majority of the existing officers."
